NEWS: India, in partnership with nine African countries, launched a major naval exercise called **AIKEYME 2025** off the coast of **Dar-es-Salaam, Tanzania**. This exercise, held over six days, is a significant step in enhancing **maritime security collaboration** between India and the African continent.

What is AIKEYME?

- AIKEYME stands for Africa-India Key Maritime Engagement.
- It is a **multilateral naval exercise**, **co-hosted** by the **Indian Navy** and the **Tanzania People's Defence Force**.
- The **first edition** of this initiative marks a significant step in strengthening maritime collaboration between India and African nations.



2. Strategic Objectives of AIKEYME

- Aims to promote maritime security and foster regional cooperation in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR).
- Part of India's vision to become a Net Security Provider in the IOR.

- Supports South-South cooperation, aligning with India's Act East and Africa Policy.
- Reinforces India's MAHASAGAR Vision: "Mutual and Holistic Advancement for Security and Growth Across Regions"

3. Key Elements of the MAHASAGAR Vision

- Strengthening ties with the Global South by engaging with African littoral states.
- Promoting collective maritime security in shared waters.
- Enhancing regional development and maritime infrastructure through partnerships.

- In addition to **India and Tanzania**, the participating African maritime nations include:
 - Comoros
 - Djibouti
 - Eritrea
 - Kenya
 - Madagascar
 - Mauritius
 - Mozambique
 - Seychelles
 - South Africa

5. Related India-Africa Defence Initiatives

a) India-Africa Defence Dialogue (IADD)

- Launched in **2020**, IADD serves as a platform for:
 - Enhancing cooperation in **maritime security**

- Addressing challenges in cybersecurity and counter-terrorism
- Facilitating **capacity-building** efforts

b) Africa-India Defence Ministers' Conference

- Aims to **deepen military synergy** and **defence cooperation** between India and African nations.
- Functions as part of a broader **regional cooperation framework**.

c) Africa-India Field Training Exercise (AFINDEX)

- Conducted in **2019** at **Pune**, India.
- Featured the participation of **17 African countries**.
- Focused on joint training, interoperability, and disaster response coordination.

6. Indian Ocean Ship (IOS) Sagar Initiative

- A new naval initiative involving joint manning of an Indian Navy ship.
- INS Sunayna, an Offshore Patrol Vessel, will be crewed by:
 - Indian sailors
 - 44 personnel from 9 African partner countries
- Reflects a **first-of-its-kind collaborative deployment**, promoting shared responsibilities in maritime governance.

- Reinforces India's commitment to **maritime peace and security** in the IOR.
- Enhances interoperability and trust-building among Indian and African navies.
- Projects India's soft power and **strategic outreach** in Africa.
